Sunday Service – Children's Work

After the worship songs in the village hall, the younger members of our congregation leave the adults and join one of our King's Kids groups – can you help out with any of the groups below? (Please note: you will be required to have a DBS check to work with children)

Younger Children's Leaders and Helpers (Rise)

Rise is for 3–6 year-olds, the children are taken from the village hall to our main church building, to have fun, play games, listen to stories, and sing songs together.

Older Children's Leaders and Helpers (Shine)

Shine is our 7-10's group the children are taken to a room at the back of the village hall for hot chocolate, games, puzzles, and conversation.

Youth Leaders and Helpers (Ignite)

Ignite is our youth group catering for 11–18 year-olds. They share a space with our Shine group. They are treated to hot chocolate as they discuss topics, have a space to ask questions, and enjoy games.

Love Your Neighbour – every other Thursday

We provide short or long-term food boxes and other support to families and individuals who are struggling to provide for themselves.

We are looking for volunteers to help with our Love Your Neighbour project. On the food box day come and hand out food, pray with people and/or deliver food to people who cannot get to us. We also welcome donations.
